I have received numerous complaints from unit owners who have been harassed by kids/teenagers who ring the doorbells of our residents, and run away. Now it has escalated to having their front doors being banged on and kicked on by kids/teenagers who again, run away. The complaints have indicated that the group of kids/teenagers may possibly be residing in our complex.

This behaviour must stop immediately and will not be tolerated by myself and the board. Any damages incurred to the front doors by the banging or kicking will fall on to the known parents of this group of kids/teenagers to repair at their cost.

These actions are destructive, annoying and can be seen as harassment. The banging and kicking can also scare elderly unit owners, little children and pets. Most unit owners have security cameras installed and if needed can be reviewed by the direction of Peel Regional Police. Talk to your children about this notice and ensure they are not participating in this group and if they are, tell them to stop immediately.
