Following is important information for every household to read and understand:

- Work is continuing on our townhomes; all units are substantially complete.
- Work will stop just before Christmas, and all construction equipment will be removed from the complex and visitors parking areas.
- Workers will return in the spring to complete some finishing activities.
- New numbers and new lights are being installed on the front and back of all units.
- Residents are reminded they must not hammer or drill holes in the siding envelope (trim or walls) as that will break the seal on the weatherproof liner and defeat the purpose of having the liner. This includes installing things like planter hooks or decorations of any sort.
